Note

Barry Morton Gough (1938 -) is a maritime and naval historian, and professor emeritus at Wilfrid Laurier University in Waterloo, Ontario. Born in Victoria, British Columbia, Gough earned a BEd at the University of British Columbia, MA at the University of Montana, and PhD at King's College, University of London. Barry Gough was a professor of history at Wilfrid Laurier University from 1972 until his retirement in 2004. He was the founding Director of Canadian Studies, Coordinator of Interdisciplinary Studies, and was the Assistant Dean of Arts and Science: Student Affairs. Barry Gough has been awarded many distinctions. In 1981 he was elected a Fellow of the Royal Historical Society. In 1991 the University of London awarded him Doctor of Literature for contributions to Imperial and Commonwealth History. In 1999 he was elected Fellow of King's College London. In 2011 the Royal Military College of Canada awarded him a Doctor of Laws.
